Aliwataka wafanyabiashara hao kushirikiana na halmashauri ya jiji pale wanapogudua kuna baadhi yao warnekuwa maelekezo kutoka ngazi husika, kama vile kuvamia maeneo yaliyotengwa kwa ajili ya shughuli za kiserikali na kuweka vibanda vyta biashara.

Kiwanda cha Ngozi Karanga kuingiza bil 80/- kwa mwaka

MRADI wa kiwanda cha bidhaa cha ngozi cha kimataifa cha Karanga, unatarajia kuingiza mapato Euro milioni 29.9 (zaidi ya Sh bilioni 79.7 kwa mwaka).

Aidha, zaidi ya wafanyakazi 7,000 wakiwemo wa kudumu 3,000 na ajira za muda maalumu 4,000 watanufaika kutokana na shughuli za uzalishaji kwenye mnyororo wa thamani.

Meneja wa kiwanda hicho, Omary Masoud alieleza hayo kwa timu ya makatibu wakuu wa wizara nne, ambazo kwa namna moja au nyingine zinanufaika moja kwa moja na kuanza na uendeshaji kiwanda hicho.

Makatibu wakuu hao ni wa Ofisi ya Waziri Mkuu (Sera, Bunge, Kazi, Ajira na Wenyé Ulemavu), Andrew Massawe, Katibu Mkuu Mifugo na Uvuvi (Sekta ya Uvuvi), Profesa Elisante Ole Gabriel, Katibu Mkuu wa Viwanda na Biashara, Profesa Riziki Shemdoe na Katibu Mkuu Mambo ya Ndani ya Nchi, Christopher Kadio na Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Mfuko wa Hifadhi ya Jamii kwa Watumishi wa Umma (PSSSF), Hosea Kashimbà.

Masoud alisema kiwanda kitazalisha jozi 4,000 za viatu kwa siku sawa na jozi milioni 1.2 kwa mwaka, jozi za soli za viatu 800,000 mpaka milioni 1.2 kwa mwaka, kuchakata ngozi futi za mraba milioni 13 kwa mwaka na kwamba asilimia 60 zitatumika kiwandani na asilimia 40 soko la ndani na nje ya nchi.

"Pamoja na bidhaa hizo, pia tutatengeneza mikoba ya wanawake na wanaume, mikanda, makoti ya aina zote, mifuko ya makochi ya magari, mifuko ya kubebéa silaha, mipira ya michezo ya aina mbalimbali na bidhaa ny- ingine za ngozi," alisema meneja huyo.

Makatibu wakuu walishiriki usimamizi wa ufungaji wa mitambo ya kisasa kwenye kiwanda hicho, kinachojengwa kwa gharama ya zaidi ya Sh bilioni 136. Kinatarajiwa kuanza kazi rasmi Oktoba mwaka huu.

Naibu Katibu Mkuu Wizara ya Viwanda na Biashara, Ludovicky Nduhiye alisema kuna haja ya serikali kutumia fedha za mfuko wa ngozi ili kuboresha mazao yatakoanayo na mifugo.

Mradi huo unaendeshwa kwa ubia katika PSSSF na Jeshi la Magereza, kwa usimamizi wa kampuni tanzu ya Karanga Leather Industries (KLICL).

taka kusambaa ovyo.



cha viatu na bidhaa zitokanazo na ngozi cha Magereza kilichopo mjini Moshi, alisema kiwanda hicho kikamilika serikali haina budi kuweka mazingira ya kitoa ajira hamsini hamsini kwa wanawake na wanaume kwani kiwanda hicho kikamilika kinawenza kutoa ajira zaidi 3000.

Alisema kama ilivyo kwa shirika la reli aliweza kuishawishi na kutoa nafasi kwa wanawake kupata tenda ya kupika vyakula n'a kuiza vinywaji ili waweze kujikwamua kiuchumi.

Naye mgombea ubunge wa Moshi Vijijini, Professa Patrick Ndakidemi aliwaomba wananchi wa jimbo hilo kumchagua kuwa mbunge wao hilo ili aweze kutumia taaluma yake ya kilimo kwa kushirikiana na wadau mali mbali kuleta maendeleo ya wananchi.

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*NARCO allocates over 200m/- for new ranch

THE National Ranching Company Limited (NARCO) says it has set aside more than 200m/- that would go towards establishing a new ranch in Muleba District, Kagera Region.

Making the revelation here yesterday, NARCO acting Director General, Masele Shilagi further said the ranch with 67-hectares would be named as 'Mwisa II' and grouped into at least 89 blocks of different sizes.

In an interview with the 'Daily News', he noted that the arrangement would bring to 16 the number of ranches owned by the state-owned company.

He further said the establishment is part of NARCO's strategies to improve performance of the livestock sector in the country, and as well limit frequent conflicts between livestock keepers and farmers com-

peting for confined land space for their individual activities.

As part of preliminary stages, Mr Shilagi said that NARCO had already spent at least 140m/- to develop the new envisioned area, which includes surveying the said 89 blocks.

"We have freely distributed at least 1,000 plots to residents, who have been residing inside the ranching areas," he added.

The Director General

equally noted that the establishment of the major facility was an important step for them to invest largely and professionally in local areas.

According to Mr Shilagi, NARCO has so far developed a crucial roadmap for the implementation of the strategic programme that would overhaul and improve the livestock keeping industry in the country for Tanzania to ensure the sector

plays a vital role in fast-tracking a pace of industrialization drive in the country.

"The livestock sector is crucial in fast-tracking the country's industrial economy, and thus, we are well prepared to ensure farmers are keeping their livestock in more professional and suitable areas," he said.

Expounding further on the plans, the Acting Director General said plans were also

afoot to start training livestock keepers on best animal breeds, and as well impart to them key knowledge on how best to keep their livestock more professional.

"We're also planning to train our staff so that they can cope with modern livestock keeping technologies, and we are planning also to recruit more staff to facilitate the company's delivering ability," he

expressed.

Recently, the company implemented a useful exercise of demarcating and fencing all its ranching blocks. According to him, the exercise was targeting to curb illegal invasion to ranching areas.

In his remarks during the climax of this year's Nana-ename exhibitions, Prime Minister Kassim Majaliwa said the fifth phase government,

through NARCO, would set aside enough grazing areas in all districts within the country.

At least two potential investors from Egypt and Nigeria have already lodged applications to invest into meat processing industries.

A total of 120 giant and small scale investors are currently with diverse interests with the state-owned company in different regions in Tanzania.

Long waited Dodoma - Iringa road construction finally begins

MPWAPWA residents may now have a reason to smile after the government's decision to start the implementation of a project for the construction of a road that connects the district to Dodoma, Iringa and Morogoro begins.

The road that would be upgraded to tarmac level follows a pledge by President John Magufuli, who once said he wants to see Mpwapwa residents improving their income through the road presence.

Speaking during a two-day working tour Dodoma Regional Commissioner (RC), Dr Binilith Mahenge, Mpwapwa District Commissioner, Jaber Shekimweri said that the promise made by Dr Magufuli had started paying off.


The RC was on his working tour to inspect different community development projects, including the 5km road in the centre of Mpwapwa promised by Dr Magufuli and that already, Tanzania Rural and Urban Road Agency (TARURA) has completed its 3km stretch.

However, he noted that the government has equally implemented the promise to construct the Mpwapwa-Kongwa road to tarmac, whose 2km out of 5 stretch has already been constructed by the Tanzania Roads Agency (TANROADS) at 4.9bn/-.

According to the DC, also, Mpwapwa residents would equally enjoy travelling on the 75-kilometre Mpwapwa-Kibakwe road after the completion of a feasibility study, besides the Iringa and Dodoma regions.

On the projects, Mpwapwa District TARURA Manager, said 3 kms of the roads that had been promised by Dr Magufuli had been completed and that the project was still active.

Reached for a comment, Mpwapwa Districts TANROADS Manager, Salome Kabunda said already 2 kms out of 5 of the Mpwapwa-Kongwa road had been com-

Institute researches, identifies new sunflower seeds for cultivation

THE Tanzania Agriculture Research Institute (TARI-Ilonga centre) has researched and identified three new sunflower hybrid seed varieties scheduled for release to potential users by October this year.

According to National Coordinator for Sunflower Research, Dr Frank Reuben, the new development is aimed at improving production and production of the crop that is currently cultivated in all regions within the country except Dar es Salaam.

According to the Global Agriculture and Food Security Programme (GAFSP) in 2016, sunflower is the most likely subsector to yield investable opportunities in Tanzania.

That is making the country set to reap several economic fortunes from its cultivation, but because of absence of enough hybrid seed varieties as in most places, farmers are reportedly still using recycled seeds slowing their progress.

Commenting further, Dr Reuben noted there are possible factors, which are likely to propel and increase production of sunflower in the future citing them potential and superior agronomic characteristics of sunflower.

Dr Reuben further noted that there was a need for alternative crop(s) in some areas of the country to increase and keep pace with demand for edible oils.

Equally, the Coordinator stated that TARI-ILO 2019 and TARI-NA 2019-new seeds have high yield of grains and oil, resistant to pests and diseases and also tolerant to drought condition.

"These are appropriate varieties for small scale and medium scale farmers. The reason is that these seeds allow farmers to produce and hence, we distribute them in Quality Declared Seed (QDS) per class within their farming community under the Tanzania Seed Certification Institute (TSCI) supervision," Dr Reuben said.

Expounding, he said the institute was now working round the clock to ensure the varieties become known, accessible and used professionally by end users.

However, he inferred that the potential for expansion of sunflower in Tanzania was enormous and that there was enough land for growing the crop, adding that its cultivation in the country has good potential for long-term success.
