**N**AIBU Waziri wa Mifugo na Uvvi, Pauline Gekul, ameutaka Wakala ya Elimu na Mafunzo ya Uvvi (FETA), kuongeza kasi ya kuzalisha wataalamu watakaokuwa na uwezo wa kuendesha meli za uvuvi wa bahari kuu zitakazonunuliwa na serikali ili kuongeza ajira na kukuza uchumi wa nchi kuiti uchumi wa bluu.

Gekul, alitoa kaulli hiyo alipofanya ziara katika ofisi za wakala huo, zilizopo wilayani Bagamoyo, mkoani Pwani, mwishoni mwa wiki iliyopita.

Alisema mpango wa serikali katika miaka mitano chini ya uongozi wa Rais Dk. John Magufuli, ni kununua meli nane zitakazotumika kwenye shughuli za uvuvi wa bahari kuu, hivyo ni muhimu kuongeza kasi ya kutoa wataalamu watakaoziendesha meli hizo pindi zitakapofika.

Aliungeza kuwa mwishoni mwa mwaka huu, meli ya kwanza itakuja, huku akisema haitapendeza kama vyombo hivyo vitakuja halafu pasiwepo na vijana watakaohusika na kuviendesha.

"Nchi inawategeremea mtoe wataalamu watakaosaidia kuendesha meli hizo zitakazoletwa kwa ajili ya uvuvi wa bahari kuu, tunaombwa mukatuzalishie wataalamu, ambao hatutapata upungufu wa wataalamu wa kuendesha vyombo hivyo," alisema.

Awali, akimkaribisha Naibu Waziri, Kaimu Ofisa Mtendaji Mkuu, Wakala ya Elimu na Mafunzo ya Uvvi (FETA), Dk. Semvuwa Mzighani, alisema wameshaingia mkataba wa maridhiano wa viwango vya mafunzo na utoaji yeti kwa wafanyakazi wa vyombo vya uvuvi wa mwaka 1995.

Alisema hatua hiyo itasaidia kutoa yeti kwa manahodha wa meli, maofisa wa meli, mabaharia na waangalizi wa meli zitakazofanya kazi katika uvuvi wa bahari

kuu.

"Huwezi kuajiriwa kule kama hauna cheti cha kukutambulisha, hivyo kuitia maridhiano haya, mabahari watapatikana kutoka katika chuo hiki," alisema.

Dk. Mzighani, aliungeza kuwa kwa Afrika, vyuo vinavyotoa mafunzo kwa wataalamu hao vipo Afrika Kusini na Misri, huku akisema ni wakati mzuri kuitia mafunzo yatakayotolewa hapa nchini, kuongeza ajira kwa vijana na kupata fedha za kigeni kuitia watu kutoka nchi nyingine watakauju kusoma katika chuo hicho.

Alisema licha ya mipango na mikakati mzuri walivyonyayo katika kuboresha huduma zao, bado wanakabiliana na changamoto kubwa ya gharama za uendeshaji wa vyuo vya uvuvi, hivyo alionomba serikali iwaongezee nguvu ili watoe wataalamu wazuri, watakaokwenda kulisaidia Taifa kukuza na kuimarisha uchumi wa bluu.

# TALIRI plans to install Centre for Dairy Excellence in Tanga Region

THE Tanzania Livestock Research Institute (TALIRI) is set to install center for Dairy Excellence (CDE) in Tanga Region to help improve performance of the crucial socio-economic sector in the country, specially milk production.

The robust project, set to start with a seed capital of at least 424bn/- is projected to serve as a major demonstration center for dairy farmers to embrace best dairy animal technologies and practices.

Acting General Director for ALRI, Dr Jesus Kizima, yesterday Adthe publication that the institute was in talks with the government to intend for availability of the

needed seed capital amount, saying however the talks were at impressive stages, added that other funds for the timely initiatives was expected to be sourced from the government of Tanzania.

"However, doors are open for stakeholders from within and outside the country to chip-in and invest in order to allow the project to be furnished with the best ever technological facilities and services," Dr Kizima expressed.

He stated, the core focus is to enable the dairy farmers in the eastern zone region of Tanga, Dar es Salaam and Coastal to heighten their milk production levels by adopting cattle with good dairy animal genetics, but also embracing key other practices.

The TALIRI's chief boss itemized

some of the key dairy technologies the envisaged center will have in offering as best animal health services, animal compounded and feeds, animal husbandry infrastructure, milk handling, grazing systems and good dairy animal genetics, among others.

"We aspire to develop the center in a professional manner to be a major Demonstration Dairy Farm Center (DDFC) for all dairy farmers within the country. Moreover, the center will also be used to offer dairy tourism to different foreigners that will be touring in the country," he insisted.

Besides, he unveiled that among others, the state-owned institution has decided to install the crucial dairy facility in the region with an eye to help the Tanga Fresh Ltd

industry to process milk at its full capacity.

According to him, the famous factory's daily milk processing capacity was at least 120,000 liters, but due to poor supply of milk from dairy farmers the facility was only processing between 50,000 and 80,000 liters.

"The other reason is that Tanga stands tall among regions within the country with many dairy cooperatives and smallholder dairy farmers hence placing the facility there will assist them improving their dairy executions, the move which will automatically manage the factory (Tanga Fresh Ltd) to start receiving needed fresh milk for processing," he added.

As the government is working tirelessly to industrialise the

country's economy by 2025, he said the institute in its side will run a diverse professional initiative to help improve performance of milk factories, possibly through increasing home milk production, the move which will also curtail milk importation.

Statistics from the Tanzania Dairy Board (TDB) depicts that during 2019/20, the country produced 3.01 billion liters of milk, out of which, 2.1 billion liters was produced from domestic dairy cows and 0.1 billion liters was from hybrid dairy cows.

However, Assistant Registrar of TDB, Noel Byamangulu, said the milk produced in the country is still not reflecting the country's actual demand, hence propelling the country to import milk from other countries.

For instance, he said during 2017/18, Tanzania imported 20,920,537.58 LMEs Kg values at 30,290.485,222/- and during 2018/19 the importation rate stood at 627,448,655Kg.

However, due to advancement of the UHT technology in Tanzania, the country's Liquid Milk Equivalent (LME) importation has kept on declining.


However, record proves that Tanzania has successfully managed to increase the number of crossbred dairy cattle at the national level 3 times from 783,000 in 2007/18 to 1,254,882 in 2018/19, the development which witnessed the country's milk production expanding from 2.4 to 2.7 billion liters.
