

Ntangeki: Mzawa anayemfurahisha Rais Magufuli kwa uwekezaji sekta ya mifugo

■ ■ ■ "NIMEFURAHISHWA na kazi nzuri iliyofanywa na mwekezaji huu, Jotham Ntangeki.

"Amesame kwekeza Karagwe. Mwekezaji so lazima atole nye, kila mtu akijipanga anowesta kuwekiza kwa kuzurua mitaji na hatia kufanya kwenye baasi za kifeda."

Hiyo ni Rais wa Jamhuri ya Muungano wa Tanzania, Dkt. John Magufuli, aliyotoua kabla ya kujewa jive la msingi katika mizadi wa ujima wa kwanda cha kuchakata maziva na mazao ya mifugo cha (Kahama Fresh) kilichopoo Kata ya Kihanga wiliyani Karagwe mkoani Kagera.

Rais Magufuli alitoua kauli mivizi uliopeza alipokuwa zaranii mkoani Kagera na kusisiza kwamba ng'ombe ni utajin mikubwa wa Tanzania ni nchi ya pili Afrika kwa kuna na mifugo mingi.

Kwa mujihi wa takwimu alizozia Rais Magufuli, Tanzania na ng'ombe millioni 33,4, mbuzi millioni 21,3, kondoo millioni 5,65, nguruwe millioni 2,12, uunda 657,387 na kuku millioni 83,28.

Anaseme maauzo ya nye ya bidhaa zitokanizo na mazao ya mifugo bado yapo chini, ilinganishwa na ukubwa wa sekta hiyo sanjan na mazao yanayopatikana.

Anaseme sekta ya mifugo hajanufurahisa nchi kiasi cha kutohia kwa upende wa mapato yato karayo na mazao ya mifugo.

Anaseme mwaka 2019 hadi 2020 zitokanizo tari kila 6,9 zenye ihmami ya sh. billioni 2,966.

Kwamba, mchango wa sekta ya mifugo kwenye palo la tafsi ni asilima 7,4 na kudai kawa kwango hicho ni kidogo ukilinganishwa na fursa iliyopo kwenye mifugo.

Anaseme yapo mambo mengi yanayowimshia sekta hiyo sitoe michango inayostahili kwa Taifa.

Anaseme sababu nyinyinge ni ukuseli wa viwanda hata unywaji mdogo wa maziva kwa mtu mmoja ni wastani wa lita 54 kwa mrawa ukilinganishwa na takwimu za kimatafa zinazotaka kuniwa lita 200 kwa mwaka.

"Maziva ni sifa na watoto wetu wanachekazi maziva, ninihukumia mwekezaji huyu kumpuni ng'ombe wazee, nimesuma mafisha yangu yatakuwa Karagwe," anaseme Rais Magufuli.

"Ntangeki, na mwekezaji ya

Wazin wa Mifugo kuwa maeneo ya mwekezaji za tafsi NARCO ambayo hayatumiki viziini yagawawe kwa wananchi watovote kufodisha na kufuga mifugo yao."

Anaseme mwaka 2019 wananchi walilehendwa kuchukua vitali ya NARCO kutokana na gharara kuwa kubwa. Hata hiyo aliyawataku wahuksika wa vitalu, hiyo kufokangalia fida kuwabu kutohia kwenye mashambaa haya na badala yako waangalia fida kuwabu itakayopatikana baadae. "Wafugaji walikilishi na kuwekeza maeneo ya kufugia mifugo yao kwanza watapata maziva ya kutosha, nyama na mazao mengine yato kuanayo na mifugo watazuu nya na nchi na watawaza kuingiza senkili mapato kutokana na kodi itakayopatikana katika sekta hiyo," anaseme Rais Magufuli.

Anaseme miogoni mwa watu wafuteteza Tanzania na wafugaji, kwani walikuwa wanachukuliwa kama watu wa daraja la chini wakienda sehemu fulani kwa ajili ya marisho ya mifugo wanatukuzwa wamekuwa watu wa kuhama hama.

"Kuna kipindi maeleko ya nyuma tulianya misako ya kuwa umiza wafugaji, wakati sekta hii inapaswa kuendeleza na kuperave ngumu," anaseme Rais Magufuli.

Anaseme pongezi zimfikie Katibu Mkuu Wizara ya Mifugo na Uvuvi, "anapenda sana mifugo aendelee kujengi viziini sekta hiyo."

Rais Magufuli anaseme vikijengi wa viwanda na Watanzania wengi walakhamashishwa kuanzisha viwanda, wafugaji watbacha taba ya kuhamashima kwa sababu watakuwa wamepata solo la ukahka ambalo ni viwanda kama kiliyovo kwanda cha Kahama Fresh.

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Rais wa Jamhuri ya Muungano wa Tanzania, Dkt John Magufuli wakati akiweka jive la msingi katika ujenzi wa miradi ya kiwanda cha kuchakata maziva cha Kahama Fresh kilichopoo Kata Kihanga wiliyani Karagwe mkoani Kagera. (Na Mipigapicha Wetu)

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Kupata maziva kutoka nya na nchi wakati na idadi kubwa ya mifugo kulkoo hizu nchi nyinyige.

Ranchi ya tafsi NARCO wana vitalu yenye maeneo makubwa, lakini mifugo ya haiongezeki cha abau muwekezaji huyo ndani ya muda mirefu mifugo imeneongezeka.

Anaseme hiyo ni changamoto kwa Wizara ya Mifugo na Uvuvi, "Kwa nini ng'ombe kufanya kazi za haiongezezo?"

Anaseme ukieni Puguri ng'ombe ni walilehendwa wakati mwingine wa kinaunganua Kongwa

pia wanapungu.

"Ninafahamu sasa hivi mma Ng'ombe 3,800 wenye imba wakisha zaa wanapunguwa tena, haiongezeki wafugaji wa kawaida ng'ombe wao wanaongezeka inawezekana kwenye ranchi ng'ombe wanauzwa, 'wanabidilishi' au kuna mchezo mchafu," anaseme Rais.

Anaseme kama Wizara ya Mifugo na Uvuvi haina watalauwa na namia ya kufuga ng'ombe waende kya mwekezaji Jotham wakilizinde niamna ya kufuga.

Anatoa maelekezo kwa Katibu Mkuu wa Wizara na Wazin wa Mifugo na Uvuvi kusimamia viziini sekta hiyo na watendaji wake ili idadiya mifugo yee inaongezeka.

Anaseme hekti kati ya 43 na 46 zile za Kongwa kuwa na ng'ombe 9,000 ni abu wakati wanazunguza eneo hilohawana maeneo ya kufuga, lakini mifugo yao inaongezeka.

Ameawaleza viongozi hao kuvuka mikukali ya kuborsoma ranchi zio ili ziweze kuvya na mifugo ya kutohia ziweze kushikeli katika uchumi wa kisozi.

Anaseme mafisha kwa kuharaka jithaa kwa kuunga mkoano jithaa za wizara kuamua kujengi kwanda cha kuchakata maziva ya oya.

Anaseme mifugo ikoborehwa yatapatikana mazao bora ya maziva, nyama yaliyo bora kwa fida ya Watanzania pa kuzua kwenye masoko ya nchi.

Anaseme unywaji wa maziva ya mafisha ya mifugo na ujima mifugo wa kuharaka jithaa kwa kuunga mkoano mbalimbali ndani ya nchi kwa ajili ya mafisha ya mifugo.

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Watugaji wanaotangatanga wawewe kufuga kwa mikataba ili wawewe kupata maeneo ya malecho.

Mkunzeni wa Kahama Fresh

Mkunzeni wa Kahama Fresh, Jotham Ntangeki, anaseme viwanda ni ajira, na uchumi kwa tafsi lohole ilialohajukukua kibashara.

Ntangeki, anaseme Kampuni ya Kahama Fresh ni ya Kitanza iliyosajili chini ya wakala ya usajji wa kampuni BRELA mwaka 2018.

Anaseme lengo la kampuni hiyo ni kufanya shughuli za urfaji na usindizi wa mazao yato kuanayo na mifugo.

Anaseme baada ya kampuni hiyo kufanya ilianza kazi ya ultugaji ambapo walikilishi heldo 3,900 kutohia ranchi za tafsi NARCO.

Anaseme ilianza kufuga ng'ombe 2,000, mbuzi 500 na kondoo 100.

Kwa sasa, anaseme kampuni 1na ng'ombe 4,109, kwembe shambu lao na mifugo na kwamba walanza kufuga ng'ombe wa maziva mwaka 2019.

Ntangeki anaseme kampuni kwa muda huu ina ng'ombe wa maziva 1,130, ng'ombe wa nyama 2,979, mbuzi 1,200 na kondoo 200.

Kwa mujihi wa Ntangeki uwekezaji katika mifugo umefikia thamani ya sh. billioni 9,8.

Anaseme kampuni imekuwa kiuza maziva kwenye masoko ya ndani na ma in vuuo 11.

Anaseme vituu hiyo vipo Kayanga, Omurusha, Bokoba na Geita, na kwamba vituu hiyo vimewekwa mtambo wa kupoza maziva.

Anaseme nNg'ombe walipo sasa wanazalisha 23,000 kwa siku.

Anaseme kuwanda hicho kinatiraha kuzalisha ajira 400 katika kwanda hicho, huko shambani kulewa na wafanyakazi 103 ambao ni watalaam, madaktari na wafanyakazi wengine wa kawada.

Kiwanda hicho kitakuma kinalayi shughuli mbele tofuhii kwa maanya ya kuchakata maziva na chakula cha mifugo.

Anaseme mafisha kwa kuharaka jithaa kwa kuunga mkoano jithaa za wizara kuamua kujengi kwanda cha kuchakata maziva ya oya.

Fisheries ministry set to review regulations

THE Ministry of Livestock and Fisheries is reviewing all the fisheries regulations in efforts to help solve challenges facing the sector, minister Mashimba Ndaki has said.

Addressing a press conference, the minister noted that several stakeholders in the fisheries sector have raised pertinent issues that can only be solved by reviewing the regulations and specifically overhaul the Fisheries Regulations, 2009.

The minister added that the ministry decided to take action following complaints raised by other stakeholders, including fishermen along the Indian Ocean, Lake Victoria and Lake Tanganyika on the amendment of the Fisheries Regulation, 2020.

He mentioned some of the challenges raised by stakeholders

such as using ring nets during the day in the Indian Ocean, measuring fishing nets using mesh gauge as outlined in the regulation and full moon fishing of sardines.

"In effort sto solve the mentioned and other challenges, the ministry will review the Fisheries Regulations, 2020 and other areas that derail sustainable fishery development in the country," said the minister.

Minister Ndaki assured the public, especially fishery stakeholders that include fishermen, fish traders and traders on fishing equipment that the ministry is doing all it takes to ensure all players in the sectors operate through common understanding.

He issued four directives for immediate implementation as the ministry awaits recommendation from a team of experts formed to look into the challenges raised by

stakeholders.

He directed the Tanzania Fisheries Research Institute(TAFIRI) to conduct a research on fishing using ring nets within two weeks and submit its report to the ministry, thereafter the ministry shall issue a statement.

On the measurement of fishing net size as outlined in the 2020 regulations, the minister said his ministry in collaboration with the Tanzania Bureau of Standards(TBS) shall determine the right measurement, stating that stakeholders should revert to using venier caliper and not mesh gauge.

The minister stated that the ministry shall issue guideline on the full moon fishing of sardines, adding that it is estimated to occur within six to seven days in a month.

He stressed the importance of solving challenges facing

the fisheries sector, noting that employs many Tanzanians. According to the minister, statistics show that in 2020, the sector provided 202,053 direct jobs to fishermen and some 4.5 million other people indirectly.

While expressing his readiness to address challenges faced by stakeholders in the sector, the minister called for cooperation in the fight against illegal fishing in the country's water bodies.

He also called for cooperation to help stop illegal exportation of fish products and control of revenue generated by the sector.

On the same note, he warned traders of fishing equipment and manufacturers to produce and sell the fishing gear legally. He urged local government authorities to cooperate with the fishing communities at their areas and strongly oversee fisheries resources in accordance with the law.

*TVLA wins tribute from parliamentary committee

THE Parliamentary Committee on Agriculture, Livestock and Water has commended Tanzania Veterinary Laboratory Agency (TVLA) operations, calling on the government to increase the agency's budget for more efficiency.

Members of the committee were of the opinion that the government need to invest fully in the agency to enable it produce more vaccines and save the livestock sector in the country.

Speaking after the agency's presentation about its operations and the future plans, TVLA acting Chief Executive Officer, Dr Stella Bilangi said the law makers were of the opinion that the government should do a lot more to increase vaccines and enable farmers access services.

Committee chairperson, Dr Christine Ishengoma noted that improving animal health is a crucial matter since animal diseases can also affect human beings.

"As we boast of having big number of livestock in the continent, it is also important to consider health of the animals," she said, adding that Tanzania should be one of the leading countries in exportation of animal products.

She also expressed the need for the government optimism to invest more money in the agency so that it can do research in terms of making new vaccines.

Muleba North MP, Charles Mwijage while speaking at the meeting argued that there is need to look at the health of animals that Tanzanians keep, saying that Tanzanian livestock are much lower in health than those from the neighbouring country.

He said TVLA should request for more money to ensure it produces vaccines that cover the whole country. "You should ask

the government to give you 10bn/- in order to produce vaccines that can serve animals in the whole country," he said.

Earlier, while making presentation before the Members of Parliament TLVA acting CEO, Dr Bilangi said the agency was asking for 2bn/- from the government.

She said if approved, the amount would enable the agency produce vaccines enough to cover 40 per cent of all animals in the country.

Dr Bilangi noted that the Agency was formed by merging the Central Veterinary Laboratory (CVL), Tsetse and Trypanosomiasis Research Institute (TTRI), Tsetse and Trypanosomiasis Research Centre (TTRC) and laboratory activities of seven zonal Veterinary Investigation Centres (VICs).

TVLA has by now a total of 12 centres following the establishment of a new Sumbawanga TVLA Centre in West Southern Zone.

The other 11 centres are, Centre for Infectious Diseases and Biotechnology (CIDB), the Central Veterinary Laboratory (CVL), Tanzania Vaccines Institute (TVI), TVLA Arusha, TVLA Dodoma, TVLA Iringa, TVLA Mtwara, TVLA Mwanza, TVLA Tabora, VVBD Kigoma and VVBD Tanga.

According to the TVLA animal health is crucial in the process of modernising the livestock sector in Tanzania.

She added that the existing and newly emerging livestock diseases, which impede livestock development need to be identified and controlled.

She said TVLA make sure that the core functions and roles of improving animal health and productivity by ensuring delivery of quality laboratory diagnostic services, enhancing vaccine production and distribution, performing animal feeds analysis and conducting animal diseases research.
