

Ntangeiki: Mzawa anayemfurahisha Rais Magufuli kwa uwekezaji sekta ya mifugo

■ ■ ■ "NIMEFURAHISHWA na kazi nzuri iliyofanywa na mwekezaji huyu John Ntangeiki. "Ameamua kuwekeza Karagwe. Mwekezaji wa lazima atoke nje, kila mtu akijipanga anaweza kuwekeza kwa kutunza mji na hata kwa kukopa kwenye basasi za kilecha."

Hiyo ni kauli ya Rais wa Jamhuri ya Muungano wa Tanzania, Dkt. John Magufuli, aliyotoka kabla ya kuweka jiwe la msingi katika maziwa ya ujenzi wa mazao ya mifugo cha (Kahama Fresh) kilichopo Kata ya Kihanga Wilayani Karagwe mkoani Kagera. Rais Magufuli alitoa kauli mwizi uliopita alipokuwa zaranzi mkoani Kagera na kusisitiza kwamba ng'ombe ni utajiri mkubwa wa Tanzania na nchi ya pili Afrika kwa kuwa na mifugo mingi.

Kwa mujibu wa takwimu alizopitisha Rais Magufuli, Tanzania ina ng'ombe milioni 33.4, mbuzi milioni 21.3, kondoo milioni 5.65, ng'utuwe milioni 2.12, uunda 657,367 na kuku milioni 83.28. Anasema mazao ya nje ya bidhaa zitokanazo na mazao ya mifugo bado yapo chini, ililinganishwa na ukubwa wa sekta hiyo sanjani na mazao yanayopatikana.

Anasema sekta ya mifugo hajarumia nchi kiasi cha kutosha kwa upande wa mapato yatakanayo na mazao ya mifugo.

Anasema mwaka 2019 hadi 2020 zilikuwa tani laki 6.9 zime thamani ya sh. bilioni 2.986.

Kwamba, mchango wa sekta ya mifugo kwenye pato la tala ni asilimia 7.4 na kudai kuwa kwango hicho ni kidogo ukilinganisha na furia iliyopo kwenye mifugo.

Anasema yapo mambo mengi yanayokwamisha sekta hiyo sioke mchango nayotafiki kwa tala.

Anasema sababu nyingine ni ukosefu wa viwanda hata uniyaji mdogo wa maziwa kwa mtu mmoja ni wastani wa lita 54 kwa mwaka ukilinganisha na takwimu za kimaisha zinazotaka kunywa lita 200 kwa mwaka.

"Maziwa ni afaa na watoto wetu wanahitaji maziwa, haramu huku mwekezaji huyu kupa ng'ombe wanne, nimeamua maziwa yangu yatakuwa Karagwe," anasema Rais Magufuli.

"Nimevutwa na majiwa ya

Waziri wa Mifugo kuwa maeneo ya ranchi za tala NARCO ambayo hayatumiki vizuri yagawewe kwa wananchi wawaze kukodisha na kutunga mifugo yao."

Anasema mwaka 2019 wananchi walishindwa kuchukua vitatu vya NARCO kutokana na gharimu kwa kubwa. Hata hivyo aliwataka wahusika wa vitatu, hivyo kutokangalia faida kubwa kutoka kwenye mashamba hayo na badala yake waangalie faida kubwa itakayopatikana baadaye.

"Wafugaji wakilindani na kupewa maeneo ya kufugia mifugo yao kwanza watapata maziwa ya kutosha, nyama na mazao mengine, yatakanayo na mifugo, watazua nje ya nchi na wataweza kuungia senikali mapato kutokana na kodi itakayopatikana katika sekta hiyo," anasema Rais Magufuli.

Anasema miongoni mwa watu walioteesha Tanzania ni wafugaji, kwani walikuwa wanachukuliwa kama watu wa daraja la chini wakienda sehemu fulani kwa ajili ya marisho ya mifugo wanatokuwa wamekuwa watu wa kuhama hama.

"Kuna kipindi mako ya nyuma tulifanya masoko ya kuwamiza wafugaji, wakati sekta hii inapaswa kuendeleza na kupewa nguvu," anasema Rais Magufuli.

Anasema pongezi zimfikie Katibu Mkuu Wazara ya Mifugo na Uvuvi, "anapenda sana mifugo aendeleo kujenga vizuri sekta hiyo."

Rais Magufuli anasema vikijengwa viwanda na Watanzania wengi wakahamasishwa kuandisha viwanda, wafugaji wataacha tabia ya kuhamama kwa sababu watakuwa wamepata soko la uhakika ambalo ni viwanda kama kilivyo kiwanda cha Kahama Fresh.

Anasema viwanda vitawasidha kuzia maziwa, watalisha mifugo yao na watatengeneza ajira kama ambavyo mmiliki wa kiwanda cha Kahama Fresh ameanza kutengeneza karibia ajira 400 sio hata kwa tala.

"Tanzania tumejichelewesha wenyewe wakati Mungu ametupa utajiri mkubwa kupita sekta ya mifugo, naipongeza Benki ya Maendeleo ya Kilimo (TADB) kwa kumkopesha mwekezaji huyu maziwa ili awize kujenga viwanda," anasema Rais Magufuli.

Anasema akienda Pugu ng'ombe ni walewale wakati mwingine wanapungua. Kongwe

"Ninafahamu sasa hivi mna Ng'ombe 3,800 wenye miba wakisha zaa wanapungua tena, hawaongezeki wafugaji wa kawaida ng'ombe wao wanaongezeka inawezekana kwenye ranchi ng'ombe wanauzwa, wanabadilishwa au kuna mchango mchafu," anasema Rais.

Anasema kama Wazara ya Mifugo na Uvuvi haina wataalam wa namia ya kufuga ng'ombe waendeleo kwa mwekezaji, Jotham wakujenga namia ya kufuga.

Anatoka maelekezo kwa Katibu Mkuu Wazara ya Mifugo na Uvuvi, Prof. Eliasante Ole Gabriel, anasema jukumu walilopewa na Rais Magufuli ni kuhakikisha wanda vyote viliyopo vinalitany kazi na kubwa viwanda vipya.

Anasema wanawazizi kuwekeza katika mazao mbalimbali ya kuchakata maziwa ya mifugo na

uvuvi, kilimo na mazao mengine ya bashara.

Waziri wa Mifugo na Uvuvi, Mashimba Ndaki, anasema wizara imejipanga vizuri kuboresha mifugo ya Watanzania ili tuweze kupata mazao bora ya maziwa, nyama na mengine.

Anasema wanamsukuru mwekezaji kwa kuunga mkono jitihada za wizara kumua kujenga kiwanda cha kuchakata maziwa na chakula cha mifugo.

Waziri anasema wizara imeweka mikakati ya kuhakikiana na waliugaji kuboresha mifugo

yao.

Anasema mifugo ikiboresha yatapatikana mazao bora ya maziwa, nyama yaliyo bora kwa faida ya Watanzania pia kuzaa kwenye masoko ya nje.

Anasema unyaji wa maziwa kwa Tanzania uko chini kwa wastani watu wanakunywa lita 54 kwa mwaka kwa mtu mmoja wakati takwimu za kimaisha zinataka kunywa maziwa lita 200.

Anasema kwa mwaka Tanzania inazalisha lita milioni 74 za maziwa, hivyo wananchi wanatakiwa kufuga mifugo iliyo

bora ili kuweza kupata maziwa ya kutosha.

Anasema wizara ya mifugo na uvuvi imeweka mpango wa kutenga na kupima maeneo mbalimbali ndani ya nchi kwa ajili ya malisho ya mifugo.

Anasema miaka mitano ijayo wizara itakuwa imetenga na kupima hekta milioni 6 za malisho ya Mifugo. Anasema mwaka huu wa fedha 2021 watapima hekta milioni 1.5 kwa ajili ya malisho.

Anasema pia wana mpango wa kuweka maji kwenye basasi ya Ranchi hizi ili kuwazidisha

Wafugaji wanaotangatanga wawaze kufuga kwa mikataba ili wawaze kupata maeneo ya malisho.

Mkurugenzi wa Kahama Fresh

Mkurugenzi wa Kahama Fresh, Jotham Ntangeiki, anasema viwanda ni ajira na uchini kwa tala lolote linalohitaji kukaa kabashara.

Ntangeiki, anasema Kampuni ya Kahama Fresh ni ya Kitarzania iliyosajiliwa chini ya wakala ya usaji wa kampuni BRELA mwaka 2018.

Anasema lengo la kampuni hiyo ni kufanya shughuli za ufugaji na usindikaji wa mazao yatakanayo na mifugo.

Anasema baada ya kampuni kusajiliwa ilianza kazi ya ufugaji ambapo walikodisha hekta 3,900 kutoka ranchi za tala NARCO.

Anasema alianza kufuga ng'ombe 2,000, mbuzi 500 na kondoo 100.

Kwa sasa, anasema kampuni ina ng'ombe 4,109 kwenye shamba lio la mifugo na kwamba walianza kufuga ng'ombe wa maziwa mwaka 2019.

Ntangeiki anasema kampuni kwa muda huu ina ng'ombe wa maziwa 1,130, ng'ombe wa nyama 2,979, mbuzi 1,200 na kondoo 200.

Kwa mujibu wa Ntangeiki uwekezaji katika mifugo umefika thamani ya sh. bilioni 9.8.

Anasema kampuni imekuwa ikiza maziwa kwenye masoko ya ndani na ina vituo 11.

Anasema vituo hivyo vipo Karagwe, Omurushaka, Bukoba na Geta, na kwamba vituo hivyo vimewekwa mitambo wa kupata maziwa.

Anasema n'Ng'ombe walipo sasa wanazalisha 23,000 kwa siku.

Anasema kiwanda hicho kinatarijiwa kukamilika kugawia Juni mwaka huu na kikanza kazi mwezi Julai mwaka huu.

Ntangeiki anasema kwamba wanataraji kuzalisha ajira 400 katika kiwanda hicho, huku shambani kukua na watanzaki 103 ambao ni wataalam, madaktari na wafanyakazi wengine wa kiwanda.

Kiwanda hicho kitakuwa kinabonywa shughuli mbili tofuti kwa maana ya kuchakata maziwa na chakula cha mifugo.

Anasema kiwanda hicho kikamilika kinatarajiwa kuchakata tani 20 za maziwa kwa siku.

Fisheries ministry set to review regulations

THE Ministry of Livestock and Fisheries is reviewing all the fisheries regulations in efforts to help solve challenges facing the sector, minister Mashimba Ndaki has said.

Addressing a press conference, the minister noted that several stakeholders in the fisheries sector have raised pertinent issues that can only be solved by reviewing the regulations and specifically overhaul the Fisheries Regulations, 2009.

The minister added that the ministry decided to take action following complaints raised by other stakeholders, including fishermen along the Indian Ocean, Lake Victoria and Lake Tanganyika on the amendment of the Fisheries Regulation, 2020.

He mentioned some of the challenges raised by stakeholders

such as using ring nets during the day in the Indian Ocean, measuring fishing nets using mesh gauge as outlined in the regulation and full moon fishing of sardines.

"In effort to solve the mentioned and other challenges, the ministry will review the Fisheries Regulations, 2020 and other areas that derail sustainable fishery development in the country," said the minister.

Minister Ndaki assured the public, especially fishery stakeholders that include fishermen, fish traders and traders on fishing equipment that the ministry is doing all it takes to ensure all players in the sectors operate through common understanding.

He issued four directives for immediate implementation as the ministry awaits recommendation from a team of experts formed to look into the challenges raised by

stakeholders.

He directed the Tanzania Fisheries Research Institute(TAFIRI) to conduct a research on fishing using ring nets within two weeks and submit its report to the ministry, thereafter the ministry shall issue a statement.

On the measurement of fishing net size as outlined in the 2020 regulations, the minister said his ministry in collaboration with the Tanzania Bureau of Standards(TBS) shall determine the right measurement, stating that stakeholders should revert to using venier caliper and not mesh gauge.

The minister stated that the ministry shall issue guideline on the full moon fishing of sardines, adding that it is estimated to occur within six to seven days in a month.

He stressed the importance of solving challenges facing

the fisheries sector, noting that employs many Tanzanians. According to the minister, statistics show that in 2020, the sector provided 202,053 direct jobs to fishermen and some 4.5 million other people indirectly.

While expressing his readiness to address challenges faced by stakeholders in the sector, the minister called for cooperation in the fight against illegal fishing in the country's water bodies.

He also called for cooperation to help stop illegal exportation of fish products and control of revenue generated by the sector.

On the same note, he warned traders of fishing equipment and manufacturers to produce and sell the fishing gear legally. He urged local government authorities to cooperate with the fishing communities at their areas and strongly oversee fisheries resources in accordance with the law.

TVLA wins tribute from parliamentary committee

THE Parliamentary Committee on Agriculture, Livestock and Water has commended Tanzania Veterinary Laboratory Agency (TVLA) operations, calling on the government to increase the agency's budget for more efficiency.

Members of the committee were of the opinion that the government need to invest fully in the agency to enable it produce more vaccines and save the livestock sector in the country.

Speaking after the agency's presentation about its operations and the future plans, TVLA acting Chief Executive Officer, Dr Stella Bilangi said the law makers were of the opinion that the government should do a lot more to increase vaccines and enable farmers access services.

Committee chairperson, Dr Christine Ishengoma noted that improving animal health is a crucial matter since animal diseases can also affect human beings.

"As we boast of having big number of livestock in the continent, it is also important to consider health of the animals," she said, adding that Tanzania should be one of the leading countries in exportation of animal products.

She also expressed the need for the government optimism to invest more money in the agency so that it can do research in terms of making new vaccines.

Muleba North MP, Charles Mwijage while speaking at the meeting argued that there is need to look at the health of animals that Tanzanians keep, saying that Tanzanian livestock are much lower in health than those from the neighbouring country.

He said TVLA should request for more money to ensure it produces vaccines that cover the whole country. "You should ask

the government to give you 10bn/- in order to produce vaccines that can serve animals in the whole country," he said.

Earlier, while making presentation before the Members of Parliament TVLA acting CEO, Dr Bilangi said the agency was asking for 2bn/- from the government.

She said if approved, the amount would enable the agency produce vaccines enough to cover 40 per cent of all animals in the country.

Dr Bilangi noted that the Agency was formed by merging the Central Veterinary Laboratory (CVL), Tsetse and Trypanosomiasis Research Institute (TTRI), Tsetse and Trypanosomiasis Research Centre (TTRC) and laboratory activities of seven zonal Veterinary Investigation Centres (VICs).

TVLA has by now a total of 12 centres following the establishment of a new Sumbawanga TVLA Centre in West Southern Zone.

The other 11 centres are, Centre for Infectious Diseases and Biotechnology (CIDB), the Central Veterinary Laboratory (CVL), Tanzania Vaccines Institute (TVI), TVLA Arusha, TVLA Dodoma, TVLA Iringa, TVLA Mtwara, TVLA Mwanza, TVLA Tabora, VVBD Kigoma and VVBD Tanga.

According to the TVLA animal health is crucial in the process of modernising the livestock sector in Tanzania.

She added that the existing and newly emerging livestock diseases, which impede livestock development need to be identified and controlled.

She said TVLA make sure that the core functions and roles of improving animal health and productivity by ensuring delivery of quality laboratory diagnostic services, enhancing vaccine production and distribution, performing animal feeds analysis and conducting animal diseases research.
