

Bring report on breaches of contract, NARCO told

LIVESTOCK and Fisheries deputy minister, Pauline Gekul has given seven days to the National Ranching Company Limited (NARCO) to submit report on how it has implemented government directives which among others required the management to take actions against investors who have violated contract terms.

Gekul gave the order in Handeni District on Saturday during her tour to inspect operations of the Mzeri ranch which is under NARCO. She said the Livestock and Fisheries Minister Mashimba Ndaki had earlier directed the management to take actions against block owners by February 15, this year.

She said the minister had even wanted NARCO to re-possess all the undeveloped blocks within its ranches.

"The minister had already directed you to take actions against all those who have failed to develop the blocks; but nothing has been done so far. I want you to submit the report within seven days," said the Deputy Minister.

Gekul faulted the management over poor supervision of the blocks which has resulted in the government losing revenues. She said block owners must be ordered to present to NARCO their payment plans as well as stating on when they complete their payments.

She however challenged NARCO to improve production of best cat-

tle breeds to be distributed to livestock keepers for production of quality meat, milk and other dairy products. She said livestock keeping in NARCO ranches should be conducted in modern ways to ensure production of quality raw materials to be supplied to available factories.

Livestock is a key agricultural sub-sector in the country. About 36-per cent of farm households are engaged in livestock-keeping, one per cent as fully livestock farmers and 35per cent as crop-livestock mix farmers.

Despite Tanzania being among African countries that have large numbers of livestock, it is yet to tap the potential.

Fishermen embrace value addition drive

FISHERIES stakeholders in Kigoma region have welcomed a new initiative to improve the sustainability of fishing in Lake Tanganyika, expecting that it will boost their economies. The region is earmarked to benefit from the euro 3m/- project in value chain addition to fresh water sprat, perch and dry sardine fished in Lake Tanganyika, making Tanzania among 10 countries picked for



It is my hope that implementing the project will solve the problems and challenges we face," he said, airing the view that the focus is to explore global markets as they demand quality products.

a project named 'Fish 4ACP,' grouping countries in the Africa, Caribbean and Pacific zone, in partnership with the UN Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO).

The five-year project is managed by the Tanzania Fisheries Research Institute (TAFIRI) and aims at giving fishermen skills to increase production and reduce post fish harvest losses before the catch reaches the market.

Speaking to reporters on a

study visit, the stakeholders were of the view that if well managed; fishing activities in the lake can vastly contribute to the region's economic uplift. Frank Kibiti, a regional official in charge of fish quality control and marketing, noted that there are great investment opportunities in value chain addition, which can increase revenues.

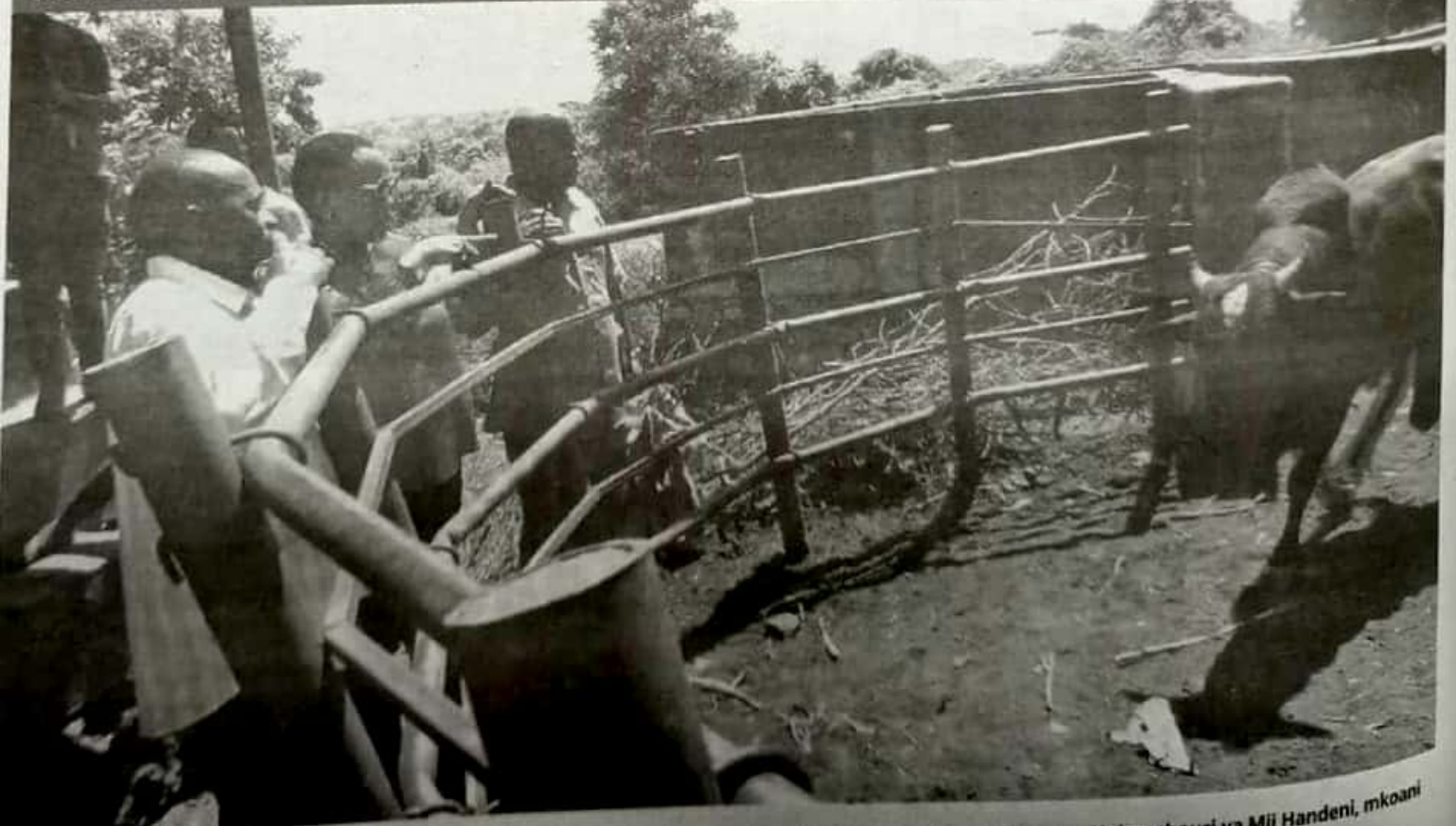
sasa hawajafanya lolote, watafutwe na wachukuliwe hatua.

Machinjio Vingunguti kuingiza bil 4/-, kutoa ajira 3,000

Jiji la Dar es Salaam linatarajiwa kuingiza zaidi ya Sh bilioni 4 kwa mwaka kutoka kwenye Machinjio ya kisasa ya Vingunguti, yanayotarajia kuariza kazi Machi mwaka huu.

Mkurugenzi wa Jiji la Dar es Salaam, Jumarte Shauri amesema kuwa utongozi wa jiji hilo, unefanya mkakato wa kuagiza magari maalumu ya kubeba nyama kwa ajili ya kuzisambaza kwa walaji.

Shauri alieleza Habari LEO jana kuwa machinjio hayo itakapoanza kazi, itatua ajira 3,000 za moja kwa moja na tayari mafurzo kwa bodhi ya wahudumu 150 wa mahali hapo yameanza.

"Matarajio wakati wowote ndani ya mwezi huu kazi rasmi za uchinji wa ng'ombe ndani ya machinjio hii itaweza kuanza, kinachosubiriwa kwa sasa ni kumaliza kwa mafunzo ya wafanyakazi wa machinjio yanayoendea kutolewa, ili kuhusu ujenzi huo kwa asilimia kubwa kila kitu kimeshakamilika" alisema.

Shauri alisema kwa kuzingatia mataakwa ya walaji wa nyama, ng'ombe watachirijwa anubahi hadi jioni ili kuocdoa msongamano unasababishwa na utamaduni wa kuchirya ngombe usiku pekee.

Alisema watatarajia kuanzia kijiwanda cha kuchakata nyama katika eneo hilo, kitakachokwa chini ya kikundi cha akina mama.

Shauri alisema kiwanda hicho kitazalisha nyama na aina mbalimbali zikawemo za kisaga na zingine kulingana na matakwa ya mlaji kisha kuuzingiza sokoni.

"Kiwanda hiki kitakachokwa kijiwanda kwa karibu na utongozi wa jiji, malengo yake ni kuhakikisha kinazalisha nyama aina tofauti tofauti yakiwemo mairi, nyama ya nundu na zingineo kisha kutiweka katika vitungashio maalumu na kumfikia mteja mahali alipo, lakini pia kuzipeleka katika 'Supermarket' kwa ajili ya kutuwa, huu ni unekazaji ambao utaongeza ufahari wa machinjio yetu" alisema.

Shauri alisema pia kutikana na uchungaji wa kisasa jiji hilo na wachinjaji, watatarajia kuvuna ngosi bora ya ng'ombe, mbuzi, na kandoo hivyo watapata toka zuri tofauti na ilivyokuwa awali.

Aliwataka wafanyabiashara wa nyama wa mkoa wa Dar es Salaam, wajandae kutumia fursa za machinjio hayo ya kisasa kwa kuwika mazingira itaruzi yatakayoawawasha watawazi kupata nyama kwa ubora ulule unozalishwa kutoka machinjio hapo.

Shauri pia aliwataka wazazi na wazafiri waji wa ng'ombe, mbuzi, na kandoo kutoka mikazi, wajandae kuongiza idadi ya mifugo inayotewa Dar es Salaam, kwa kuwa mazingira ya machinjio hayo kwa sasa yamekawa bora kuwawasha zaidi ya mifugo 5,000 kachinjwa kwa siku.
