THE DAIRY INDUSTRY (RAW MILK GRADING AND MINIMUM QUALITY AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2020

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Dairy Industry (Raw Milk Grading and Minimum Quality and Safety Requirements) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020 and shall be read as one with the Dairy Industry (Raw Milk Grading and Minimum Quality and Safety Requirements) Regulations, 2007, herein after referred to as the "principal Regulations."

Amendment of regulation 3

2. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting the definition of the term "Tanzania Standards" and substituting for it the following:

"national standards" means a standard published under the Standard Act;

Amendment of Part II

3. The principal Regulations are amended in the title of Part II by inserting between the words "Grading" and "of Raw Milk" the word "Selling".

Amendment of regulation 5

4. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 5 and substituting for it the following:

"Weighing and grading of raw milk

- **5.**-(1) Every shipment of raw milk supplied by a producer shall be weighed, tested and graded as prescribed in the First Schedule to these Regulations.
- (2) Sampling and Test methods, farther testing of raw milk regarding veterinary drugs, pesticides residues, mycotoxins, heavy metals and other requirements shall be done as prescribed in the

national standards."

Amendment of regulation 10

- **5**. The principal Regulations are amended in Regulation 10 by deleting subregulation (3), (4) and (5) and substituting for them the following:
 - "(3) A person shall not offer for sale, sell or supply unpasteurised milk to any person unless such milk sold or supplied to milk collection centres or milk processing factories.
 - (4) A person shall not sell or supply milk containing drug residues or any harmful chemical residues including pesticide residues above levels prescribed in the national standard.
 - (5) A person shall not sell or distribute raw milk containing more than $0.50\mu g/l$ of aflatoxin M1 when tested as per national standards."

Amendment of regulation 12

6. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 12(2) by deleting the words "fifty thousand" and substituting for them the words "one million".

Addition of regulation 12A

7. The principal Regulations are amended by adding immediately after regulation 12 the following:

"Compounding of offences

- 12A.-(1) Where a person admits in writing that he has committed an offence under these regulations, the Registrar or any authorized officer in writing, may, at any time prior to the commencement of the proceedings by a court of competent jurisdiction, compound such offence and order such person to pay a sum of money not exceeding one half of the amount of the fine to which such person would otherwise been liable to pay if he have been convicted of such offence.
- (2) Subject to subregulation (1), a person whose an offence has been compounded shall fill compounding form prescribed in the Second Schedule to these Regulations and make payment of the penalty imposed within fourteen

days.

(3) Failure to make payment within the prescribed time as provided for in subregulation (2), a person whose an offence has been compounded shall pay a penalty and interest of 20% of such penalty."

Amendment of Schedules

8. The principal Regulations are amended in the Schedules by deleting First, Second and Third Schedules and substituting for them the following:
