Ulega: Tumieni uvunaji mifugo kumaliza migogoro

NAIBU Waziri wa Mifugo na Uvuvi, Abdallah Ulega ameutaka uongozi wa Mkoa wa Pwani kutumia mkakati wa uvunaji wa mifugo kumaliza migogoro ya wafugaji na wakulima pamoja na kuondokana na uhaba wa malighafi katika viwanda vya kuchakata nyama mkoani humo.

Alisema hayo juzi alipokutana na uongozi wa mkoa huo ukiongozwa na mkuu wa mkoa huo, Abubakar Kunenge.

Ulega alisema viongozi ndani ya mikoa yote nchini ni vyema wakaunda kamati maalumu za wataalamu kwenda wilayani hadi vijijini ili kutafuta ufumbuzi wa haraka na kudumu wa kumaliza migogoro ya wakulima na wafugaji.

Pia kuhakikisha wafugaji wanavuna mifugo yao kwa kuuza

katika viwanda vya kuchakata nyama ili vipate malighafi na kuuza nyama ndani na nje ya nchi.

Alisema serikali inalichukulia suala hilo kwa uzito mkubwa kwa kutumia kamati maalumu kutoka Wizara ya Ardhi, Nyumba na Maendeleo ya Makazi, Wizara ya Maji, Wizara ya Kilimo na Wizara ya Mifugo na Uvuvi.

"Timu hizo zitabaini maeneo ya mifugo vamizi, wafugaji wakorofi ili waweze kuchukuliwa hatua na kubainisha mahitaji halisi ya miundombinu ya mifugo, kuwepo kwa taarifa kamili za mifugo ilipo pamoja na kuhamasisha kuwa na utamaduni wa kuuza mifugo kwenye viwanda vya kuchakata nyama ili vipate malighafi," alisema Ulega.

Akizungumzia hatua zilizo chukuliwa na mkoa kukabiliana na kero hiyo, Kunenge alisema tayari wameanza kufanya sensa ya mifugo katika wilaya zote,

na Wilaya ya Rufiji kwa sasa ipo hatua za mwisho kukabidhi mapendekezo yao.

Katika taarifa hiyo ya sense, wamebaini kuna wafugaji wengi waliopo katika wilaya hiyo hawajasajiliwa na hawana taarifa zozote za wanakotoka wala wanakokwenda.

Katika hatua nyingine, Ulega akiwa katika Taasisi ya Chanjo Tanzania (TVI) iliyopo Wilaya ya Kibaha, aliagiza uongozi huo pamoja na wizara wanaohusika na masuala ya chanjo kuhakikisha chanjo zinazozalishwa na taasisi hiyo zinawafikia wafugaji waliopo vijijini badala ya kuanza kufikiria kusambaza chanjo hizo nje ya nchi.

Alisema kuna mifugo mingi kama kuku, ng'ombe na mbuzi wanaokufa kwa kuwa wafugaji hawajui kama kuna chanjo zinazozalishwa hapa nchini, ingawa kuna maeneo mengine chanjo hizo hazijafika kabisa.

NAIBU Waziri, Ofisi ya Makamu wa Rais (Muungano na Mazingira), Hamad Chande ametoa siku tatu kwa uongozi wa Manispaa ya Songea kulipa madeni ya vibarua wanaofanya kazi katika machinjio ya kisasa ya Shule ya Tanga.

Chande alitga agizo hilo juzi wakati alipotembelea

machinjio hayo akiwa katika ziara ya siku tatu katika Mkoa wa Ruvuma kujionea utekelezaji wa utunzaji wa mazingira na uhifadhi wa vyanzo vya maji.

Akiwa katika machinjio hayo, Naibu Waziri alipata malalamiko kutoka kwa baadhi ya vibarua ya kutolipwa stahiki zao tangu machinjio hayo yaliyopoanza kufanya kazi Mei mwaka huu.

"Kwa kuwa mkurugenzi hapa hayupo, basi nakuagiza

tarehe 15 (kesho) hakikisheni mnalipa madeni yote mnayodaiwa. Pia mkuu wa wilaya nakuomba fuatilia malipo ya hawa vijana, siyo ustaarabu hata kidogo mtu unampa kazi lakini wakati wa malipo unamzungusha... hili sipendi lijitokeze tena," alisema Naibu Waziri.

Aidha, aliagiza kufanyiwa marekebisha kadhaa katika machinjio hayo ikiwemo mfumo wa maji taka na kuwapa vifaa vya usalama vijana wanaofanya

kazi katika machinjio baada ya kushuhudia wakifanya kazi mbalimbali kama kuondoa damu sakafuni na kusafisha sehemu ya kinyesi cha wanyama wanaochinjwa bila ya kuvaa vifaa kinga.

Mwenyekiti wa Umoja Wachinja Nyama katika machinjio hayo, Ased Ali alisema wanakabiliwa na uhaba wa vifaa vya kufanyia kazi kama vile visu, kofia ngumu, buti na wafanyakazi wachache, hivyo ameiomba manispaa kuwapatia vifaa na

kuongeza idadi ya watumishi ili watekeleze majukumu yao.

Kwa upande wake, Kaimu Mhandisi wa Ujenzi wa manispaa hiyo, Caroline Bernard alisema mradi wa machinjio ulianza kutekelezwa kwa awamu mbili; awamu ya kwanza ulianza Julai 2017 na kukamilika Machi 2019 na awamu ya pili ulianza Januari 2020 na kukamilika Desemba 2020 kwa gharama ya Sh 5,748,799,559.

Awamu ya kwanza ya utekelezaji wa mradi wa machinjio imefanywa na Mkandarasi Girraf Investment Ltd kwa gharama ya Sh 2,725,624,900 na kusimamiwa na Mhandisi Mshauri S&F Consultancy kwa gharama ya Sh 232,260,000 na hivyo kufanya gharama ya mradi kwa kipindi hicho kuwa Sh 2,957,884,900.

Alisema kilichowasukuma kuleta mbegu hiyo ni kutokana na faida za kuku hao ikiwamo nyama nyingi kutokana na kuwa na uzito mkubwa na utamu wake.

Alisema kuku mtetea hutaga mara mbili kwa

mwaka mayai 15 kwa mara moja, hivyo kutaga mayai 30 kwa mwaka, wakati kuku wa kawaida wa kienyeji hutaga zaidi ya mayai 50 kwa mwaka.

"Hawa kuku ni wapya, ndio tumewaleta sasa. Tuliwanunua jogoo na mtetea kwa ajili ya mbegu Sh milioni 1.5 wote na tangu watotolewe wana miezi minane sasa hivi, wana nyama nyingi na wanakuwa kwa haraka, mtetea ana kilo nne mpaka nne na nusu na jogoo anakuwa na kilo tano mpaka sita," alisema.

Alisema walipata soko la

kuwaleta kuku hao mwaka jana na sasa wanapambana kuwazalisha kwa wingi kwani wanasoko kubwa.

Alisema kifaranga cha wiki mbili huuzwa kwa Sh 15,000 hivyo ili mtu apate mbegu atalipa Sh 30,000 na cha mwezi mmoja ni Sh 30,000, huku mbegu ya mtetea na jongoo ikiwa ni Sh 60,000.

Kwa mujibu wa Namara, jogoo wa aina hiyo ya kuku, hapandi kuku mwingine hivyo kuwa na uhakika na aina ya vifaranga na si mkorofi kama jogoo wa Kuchi.

TAASISI ya Utafiti wa Mifugo Tanzania (TALIRI), imesema itaendelea kubuni teknolojia mpya za kuboresha na kuinua sekta ya ufugaji ili kuhakikisha inaleta tija zaidi kwa wafugaji na kwa uchumi wa nchi.

Kauli hiyo ilitolewa na Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa TALIRI, Prof. Erick Komba, katika banda lao kwenye Maonyesho ya 45 ya Kimataifa ya Biashara ya Kimataifa Dar es Salaam

(DITF).

Alisema zipo teknolojia nyingi ambazo wamezibuni zinazolenga kuboresha zaidi sekta ya ufugaji ikiwamo kuwa na ng'ombe wa kisasa aina ya Mpwapwa ambaye anazalisha maziwa mengi na nyama nyingi tofauti na ilivyo kwa ng'ombe wa asili.

"Baada ya kubuni na kubaini tija zinazotokana na huyu ng'ombe aina ya Mpwapwa, tunachofanya ni kusambaza kwa wafugaji ili nao wakimfuga wapate tija kubwa kwa

kupitia maziwa na nyama na kuboresha maisha yao," alisema Prof. Komba.

"Kwa hiyo kila mwaka tunasambaza kama madume 150 kwenye mikoa na halmashauri mbalimbali za kifugaji ili watu wayatumie kuzalishia ng'ombe wa kienyeji ili anayezaliwa awe amechukua baadhi ya sifa zinazofanana na huyu anayetoa maziwa na nyama nyingi, kwa hiyo unakuwa unamwongezea yule wa kiasili uwezo wa uzalishaji."

Aliwashauri wafugaji kuacha ufu-

gaji wa mazoea na badala yake kufuga mifugo ambayo itawaletea tija.

"Ushauri wangu mkubwa kwa wafugaji ni kwamba waache ule ufugaji wa mazoea, ufugaji ambao unakuwa na mifugo mingi lakini inakuwa haina tija, kwa mfano mtu anakuwa na ng'ombe wa kienyeji 20. Lakini unakuta kila mmoja anatoa lita moja ya maziwa, wakati ukiwa na ng'ombe mmoja huyu wa kisasa aina ya Mpwapwa anakupa lita nane(8) ambazo ni kama zinazotoka kwa ng'ombe nane wa kienyeji."

"Kwa hiyo inabidi tuhame kutoka huko kwa sababu itatusaidia kufuga ng'ombe wenye tija na itapunguza migogoro ambayo imekuwa ikitokea ya wakulima na wafugaji."

Pia, Prof. Komba aliwataka wafugaji kuingia kwenye teknolojia ya kisasa ya kupanda majani ya malisho bora kwa mifugo yao.

"Kwa hiyo hata vijana au wama-na nao wanaweza kuona hii fursa wakawekeza kwenye teknolojia hii na watafanya biashara sana."

* Stop over charging livestock keepers, councils ordered *

THE government has cautioned Councils in the country to avoid inflating and charging unnecessary levies on livestock as this could easily scare investors.

The caution was made by the Minister for Livestock and Fisheries Development, Mashimba Ndaki over the weekend in the Kagera region.

Equally, the minister explained that the government had banned transporting livestock at night provided traders have valid documents.

Mr Ndaki was on a three day working tour in the region, where he held talks with the leaders and inspected various livestock projects being implemented in the area.

He also explained that the livestock sector plays a key role in the nation's economy, and called for concerted efforts from all the stakeholders, including the private sector.

"The private sector plays a key role in the country's ambitious plans to achieve industrialization. Local government authorities should work closely and assist the private sector including investors in the livestock sector," he said.

During the meetings, several traders at the Bukoba Municipal Council's abattoir raised concern that they had been banned from transporting cattle bought at Biharamulo auction.

One of the traders, Ms Johari Kassim, said she was recently fined 200,000/- for violating the directive. "The directive had negatively affected our livestock business," she complained.

Minister Ndaki later visited Mabale Ranch in Missenyi district where he held face-to-face discussions with livestock investors, who were allocated blocks at the Ranch.

The small-scale livestock investors told him that they had complied with all the required standards, including paying lev-

ies, but for the past three years, they had been evicted from the blocks in favour of a large-scale livestock investor, who was identified as Chobo Investment Company Ltd.

After hearing from the sides involved in the saga, Minister Ndaki declared that Chobo Investment Company Ltd would be allocated an alternative block, thus allowing seven small-scale livestock investors to relocate to their earlier blocks.

He also said small-scale livestock investors who fulfilled the requirement and had already paid the levies would be allowed to sign a contract for five years instead of the current one year.

Kagera Region comprises five Ranches with 179,967 hectares under the National Ranching Company (NARCO). They include Kitengule (41,700 hectares), Missenyi (60,851 hectares), Mabale (14,026 hectares), Kagoma (50,690 hectares) and Kikulula (12,700 hectares).



Govt concedes NARCO project land to villagers

THE government has rescinded its earlier decision to evict over 2,000 households from a public forest in Muleba district, Kagera region, where the National Ranching Company (NARCO) was already putting up a new farm.

The state-owned company has unsuccessfully tried to evict the 'invaders' for the past five years as it continued pumping funds to develop the 69 hectares that it calls Mwisu II Ranch.

Livestock and Fisheries minister Mashimba Ndaki (pictured) toured the area yesterday and announced that residents of 2617 households living in the government land will no longer be evicted.

He said the decision has been made because the forest has enough land to accommodate both the residents and the ongoing investment by NARCO.

"A formalisation team made up of



Presenting his estimates, Ndaki said that as of 30 April 2021, NARCO had a total of 16,725 cattle, 3,307 goats, 3,155 sheep and 31 horses

officials from the ministry, the district and NARCO will sit and decide on which blocks are turned into villages and demarcated as such," he explained.

"We will ensure that the villagers will continue with their activities without interfering with the operations of the investor-NARCO," the minister declared.

In September last year, NARCO announced that it was spending over 200m/- to survey the land which was being grouped into 89 blocks of different sizes.

Investing in the new ranch was part of its strategies to improve the performance of the livestock sector and control encroachment by herders and farmers into government land.

NARCO has recently been on the spotlight over its performance amid increased conflicts with herders and farmers who have settled within its ranches in the past decades, the ranching utility had stated.

Debating the Livestock and Fisheries ministry budget estimates for 2021/22 in the National Assembly in May, lawmakers argued that keeping domestic animals profitably can only be undertaken by the private sector and not by government

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Ministry wants regional land issues committees

LIVESTOCK and Fisheries deputy minister Abdallah Ulega has directed regional commissioners whose areas have land conflicts pitting herders and farmers to form committees of experts to solve the problem.

He was addressing regional government officials led by Regional Commissioner Abubakar Kunenge, during his two-day tour of the region.

Local leaders said the conflicts—some of which have been running for decades—are costly to the nation and must be put to an end.

The terms of references for the committees of experts need to visit conflict-hit areas and discuss the issued at district and village levels, interview the concerned parties to find who is aggrieved so as to propose solutions, he stated.

"The committees to be formed will help to identify areas that have been invaded by stubborn herders so that steps are taken against them," he elaborated.

"The committees should be tasked to identify the actual needs in regard to livestock infrastructures, exhaustive

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
