* Mfumo wa ukaguzi wa mifugo wazinduliwa

WAZIRI wa Mifugo na Uvuvi, Mashimba Ndaki amezindua mfumo wa ukaguzi wa mifugo na mazao ya mifugo na kuwataka watakootekeleza mfumo huo kutoageuka kuwa polisi na watoa hukumu kwa wananchi.

Katika uzinduzi huo uliofanyika Dodoma jana, alisema mfumo huo ni rahisi na ni wa ushirikishwaji, hivyo ni yema wakaguzi kuutumia ipasavyo na si kugeuka kuwa polisi na kuwasumbua wadau wa sekta ya mifugo.

"Utaribu huu ni wa ushirikishwaji, sasa tunapokuwa huko kufanya ukaguzi kuhusiana na ubora na viwango tusijigeuze kuwa polisi. Kwa nchi yetu mfumo huu ni rahisi na ambao umelenga kuzipatia taarifa wizara, taasisi na wadau wengine kuhusiana na ukaguzi, ubora na usalama wa mifugo pamoja na mazao yake."

"Sasa utashangaa watu tunaowashirikishwa kufanya kazi hizi za ukaguzi wanageuka kuwa polisi kwa kuanza kukamata, kutoza faini na kusumbua watu, niwaombe mfumo huu ni mzuri, tufanye kazi kwa kufuata inavyoelekeza, tuusijigeuzi kuwa wahukumu wa wenzetu," alisisitiza.

Ndaki alisema umuhimu wa mfumo huo ni kulinda afya za walaji, mifugo na mazao yake kwa kusimamia sheria, kanuni na taratibu, jambo ambalo litasaidia wafugaji kuzalisha mifugo kwa tija kwa kutumia pembejeo na huduma zilizosajiliwa na kutambuliwa kisheria.

Aidha, aliwataka watalamu wa wizara, mamlaka za serikali za mitaa, taasisi na wadau waliopo kwenye vyama vya tasnia kuhakikisha wakaguzi, wazalishaji, watoa huduma kwenye mifugo wanazingatia sheria, kanuni, taratibu na miongozo iliyopo ili kuhakikisha mlaji anaendelea kunufaika kifaya na kimaslahi kupitia maziwa, nyama na mayai na bidhaa nyingine za mifugo.

Awali, Kaimu Katibu Mkuu (Mifugo), Amosy Zephana alisema wizara hiyo imeanzisha na kuboresha mfumo wa ukaguzi wa mifugo na mazao yake ambao umejikita kwenye tasnia za kuku, maziwa, nyama, mayai, ngozi, malicho na rasilimali a vyakuka vya mifugo.

* Form coop societies to get loans, fishermen told *

ARTISANAL fishermen, fish processors and traders need to form groups to be able to acquire loans from banks to increase productivity in their activities.

Speaking at a workshop to validate research findings on Lake Tanganyika sprat, sardine and perch value chain in Kigoma, the Director of Aquaculture in the Ministry of Livestock and Fisheries, Dr Nazael Madalla said the government was focused to promote cooperative societies in the small-scale fishery sector to attract loans and financial support from banks and other institutions.

Financing opportunities in fisheries sector are opening... The issue here is how to help these fishermen work commercially," said Dr Madalla, who represented the Permanent Secretary in the ministry, Dr Rashid Tamatama at the workshop that brought together stakeholders in Lake Tanganyika small-scale fisheries sector.

Two cooperative societies in Lake Victoria have acquired loans to buy fishing boats, fish preserving facilities and sardine drying kiln, he said.

He said providing loans to the fisheries sector was among priorities of the Tanzania Agricultural Development Bank (TADB) whose newly appointed Managing Director,

Frank Nyabundege had called on them to discuss financing opportunities in the sector.

He said the government looks at cooperative societies as the way to go to expedite development in the small-scale fishery sector as they are potential to contribute to responsible fisheries, food security, women's empowerment and poverty eradication.

It would also be much easier for the government, banks and financial institutions to reach and offer services to a group than unorganized fishermen, processors or traders, he said.

From a production and marketing perspective joining forces through cooperatives would enable fishermen, processors and traders to take advantage of government initiatives to boost growth of the fisheries sector.

He said the government had set aside 50bn/- in the current financial year to build fishing port in Bagamoyo, Coast Region and would also set aside funds for upgrading infrastructures of fish landing sites in Lake Tanganyika shores.

"We see the importance of the contribution of fisheries in food and nutrition security. Not only that but also its importance to the economy. We want fishermen efforts shouldn't be wasted at landing sites. Why should he be forced to sell his fish at low prices just because he can't put them in a freezer?"
