THE Deputy Minister for Livestock and Fisheries, Abdallah Ugoza has said the government is set to make more sardines from Lake Tanganyika become a strategic commercial product to attract investors and spur both individual and the nation's economic development.

Ugoza made the remarks at the weekend when addressing stakeholders in the fisheries sector at Kavanga Island port in Bujumbura Region.

He said the government intends to make the area itself fish harvested from Lake Tanganyika a strategic crop since it made another 100,000 people in the community.

"We at the [fish] port, [have]

to strengthen the trade, we want investors to develop themselves commercially and we have planned to review all obstacles the areas stakeholders to do this and we shall also attract the business to attract more investors," said Ugoza.

The Deputy Minister also called on Egresa regional offices to embark on a special strength campaign to advertise the quality of the dry sardine fish to users in both local and foreign processing factories for export.

Ugoza said a good advertising

industry and financial institutions will invest and that would the eye for the fish to be sold commercially due to lack of local markets.

He also said the government intends to facilitate investors with various incentives to enable them engage in better modern fishing and fish drying practices to enhance the products quality.

For his part, Bungee Bujumbura managing director said he believes the government was doing a lot of research because the foreign

fishing port is not well built so facilitate fish traders conduct their business.

Bungee Bujumbura managing director, Khourbe Nganda said because the country was developing to the fine Bungee that calls for enhancing production given the links and the role for the country's economic growth, the government should see the need to reform some of the positions to enable more foreign participation in the fish industry.

Drama at EAC as member states fall out over jobs

A dispute over the recruitment of staff in the regions of the East African Community (EAC), which has simmered for close to a decade, came to a head last week when the bloc's legislative assembly blocked the firing of three clerks over irregularities in the recruitment process.

On Wednesday, powers retained in the East African Legislative Assembly (Eala) in Arusha over the firing of a clerk and a deputy, signaling growing discontent with the existing rules in the Community.

Ugandan legislators led by Lewis Namara have been at the forefront of the quest for equity in the recruitment of staff, ultimately staging walkouts that made Namara the key target of a Tanzanian court on Thursday due to lack of quorum.

The Eala started sitting in Arusha on October 3 and are expected to run until October 20.

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An extraordinary Council of Ministers meeting scheduled to last Wednesday, which was expected to resolve the staff recruitment process, had to be moved to a later date, perhaps in the next week, as the grouping of Uganda's EAC state Minister Dennis Ntagala, who had reportedly quit.

Later on Friday, Ntagala wrote to the Secretary-General demanding that the instructions set for creation of the six specific government posts at the EAC organs and institutions be deleted.

"We are not aware EAC partners

have agreed that a joint committee have been created for the intention to be operational eligible conditions and that at the beginning of each recruitment process, the EAC Secretariat shall inform each partner state about the balance of reserved posts, prior to Article 45 of the Operational Manual for the implementation of the Quota System. In respect to the power to make administrative decisions the Republic of Uganda respects governments in the operations, until the partners submit the plan of action to each other for each partner state prior to the date of advertising the post," it interjected in a letter to EAC secretariat.

Some have cast doubt on Uganda's bill's constitutionality, saying they have given no clear Wright it has such a provision.

In a motion tabled in the Assembly, Namara chair of the General Purpose Status Committee proposed that the process of recruiting a Finance clerk as deputy, interdicted in July failed adherence to the EAC's quota system which requires equity in staffing.

"We urge the EAC to suspend its work and recruitment process for updating the principles, regulations and relevant legislation, the truth, the solution and mechanism for implementation of agreements," said Namara.


"We call for a review and the quota system will remain applied to citizens for positions in the job placements covering of each country and also having real exercise of candidates to the job recruitment process," he said.

Allendelea kusema kuwa zao hilo la dagaa likitangazwa vizuri, wawekezaji na taasisi za benki watakwenda kuwekeza na ndio utakuwa mwisho wa dagaa wa Kigoma kutupwa hivyo kwasababu ya kukosa soko.

Aliongeza kuwa uvunaji wa dagaa hao unapaswa uendane na utunzaji wa mazalia ya samaki ili upatikanaji wa rasilimali hiyo uwe wa uhakika wakati wote.

"Ndugu zangu, mkakati huu wa kuinua bishara ya zao la dagaa hautafanikliwa kama malighafi haitakuwepo, ili viwanda vianzishwe ni lazima malighafi ipatikane ya kutosha," alisistiza.

Ulega alisema serikali imejipanga kuwawezesha wawuvi vifaa mbalimbali vitakavyowasaidia kuvuna dagaa kwa uhakika na kuwakausha kwa kutumia vichanja vya klsasa, ili kupunguza upotetu wa dagaa na kuongeza ubora wake.
