

* NIPASHE UK 3 * Chanjo ya lazima kwa mifugo yaja *

SERIKALI inatarajia kuanzisha utaratibu wa kutoa chanjo ya lazima kwa mifugo kila baada ya miezi mitatu lengo likiwa kuzuia magonjwa kwa mifugo binadamu na kuipa thamani nyama ya Tanzania katika masoko ya kimataifa.

Waziri wa Mifugo na Uvubi, Abdallah Ulega, alisema hayo jana ikulu, jijini Dar es Salaam, wakati wa mukutano na waandishi wa habari uliolenga kutoa mrejesho wa ziara ya Rais Samia Suluhu Hassan aliyoifanya Morocco na Saudi Arabia hivi karibuni.

Ulega alisema hivi sasa kuna tati zo kubwa la mifugo nchini kushambuliwa na magonjwa yanayosababisha athari mbalimbali vikiwamo vifo, magonjwa kwa binadamu pindi anapokula nyama yenyeye vimelea vyatupu na nyama kutukukidhi ubora katika masoko ya kimataifa.

Alisema kutokana na hali hiyo, wizara inatarajia kuanzisha kampeni ya kuchanja mifugo kwa lazima kwa utaratibu maalum na kampeni hiyo itazindiliwa na Rais Samia. Mbali na kampeni hiyo, alisema Rais Samia pia atazindua kiwanda kitakachotengenza chanjo hizo.

"Utawekwa utaratibu maalum wa kuchanja, kama ni kila baada ya miezi mitatu, kwamba kila mfugaji atalazimika kuchanja mifugo yake. Tunataka tuuze kwa wingi nyama katika soko la kimataifa, pamoja na kuzuia magonjwa yatokanayo na kula nyama yenyeye virusi," alisema Ulega.

Ulega alisema mwaka 2021 Tanzania iliuza nyama tani 1,700 katika soko la dunia na hadi sasa tani

14,000 zimeshauzwa kiasi ambacho ni kldogo.

Alisema hadi Juni, mwaka huu Saudi Arabia illinunua tani 1,400 za nyama kutoka Tanzania huku mahitaji yao yakiwi ni tani 21,000.

"Bado tunafuga kizamani; tunafuga kimila. Tunatakiwa tufuge kibashara, tunatakiwa tupeleke mifugo sokoni. Ni kweleli mifugo ni utajiri lakini ni lazima ifike sokoni," alisema Ulega.

Mkurugenzi wa Mashariki ya Kati kutoka Wizara ya Mambo ya Nje na Ushirikiano wa Afrika Mashariki, Balozi Abdallah Kilima, aliwasihii Watanzania wanaokwenda kufanya kazi katika nchi za Mashariki ya Kati wafuate utaratibu ili wawe salama.

Alisema nchi za Mashariki ya Kati zinategemea nguvu kazi kutoka kwa wageni wa naofika kufanya kazi.

Balozi Kilima alitolea mfano akisema Oman ina idadi ya watu milioni tano lakini watu milioni

2.4 ni wageni. Kati ya wageni hao, kutoka India ni 800,000 na Wapakistan ni 300,000. Pia alisema Umoja wa Falme za Kiarabu (UAE) asilimia 60 ya wakazi wake ni wageni.

Alisema asilimia 92 ya taarifa kwamba wageni wanateswa katika nchi za Mashariki ya Kati si kweli, akitolea mfano kwamba kuna Watanzania 25,000 Oman kati yao 17,000 wanafanya kazi za ndani.

"Wafanyakazi wa ndani Oman kima cha chini wanalipwa Dola za Marekani 300 kwa mwezi. Wako Watanzania wanaohudumia familia zao huku Tanzania kwa kazi wanazofanya Oman. Ukifuata utaratibu hutapata matatizo," alisema.

Mkurugenzi wa Uhamasishaji Uwekezaji kutoka Kituo cha Uwekezaji Tanzania (TIC), John Mathew, alisema kuanzia Julai hadi Septemba, mwaka huu, TIC iméandikisha miradi 137 na kutengeneza ajira 86,900.

* Majaliwa aagiza wanaolisha mifugo mashambani wachukuliwe hatua *

Na MWANDISHI MAALUMU, Lindi

WAZIRI Mkuu, Kassim Majaliwa, amemwagiza Kamanda wa Polisi Mkoa wa Lindi, ahakikishe wafugaji walioingiza mifugo katika mashamba na kusababisha uharibifu wa mazao, wakamatwe na kufikishwa mahakmani kwani hakuna ye yote ambaye yuko juu ya sheria.

Majaliwa alitoa agizo hilo wilayani Ruangwa mkoani Lindi, jana alipozungumza na wananchi katika vijiji vya Namkatila, Matambarale na Nandandala akiwa katika ziara ya kukagua miradi ya maendeleo inayotekelzeza.

Alisema vijiji hiyo ni mi mongoni mwa maeneo yaliyoathirika zaidi na migogoro ya wakulima na wafugaji ikiwemo mkulima mmoja kuuawa.

"Serikali iko macho na itamchukulia hatua yeyote anayeathiri shughuli za wengine, Tanzania ni nchi inayoendeshwa kwa kufuata sheria, kanuni na taratibu, hiyo watendaji wote wa vijiji wawajibike-kwa kutekeleza majukumu

yao ipasavyo kuepusha migogoro isiyi na tija. Tutaendelea kuwalinda wananchi," alisema.

Waziri Mkuu alisema serikali haitovumilia kuona jamii ya wafugaji wasiozingatia sheria na haitatoa nafasi kwa wakulima kuendelea ku haribiwa mazao yao.

"Jambo hili halikubaliki na hatua kali zitachukuliwa kwa watu wote wanaotaka kuvuruga amani, serikali haitavumilia vitendo hiyo... Hatutamsamehe mfugaji anayetumia fimbo yake kumpiga mkulima baada ya kulisha mifugo katika shamba lake.

"Hatuna nafasi ya kushuhudia hayo, utaratibu lazima uzingatiwe, tukomeshe migogoro ya wafugaji na wakulima. Tumuache mkulima aendelee kulima avune. Tusilinde waovu," alisema.

Majaliwa alisema kauli ya serikali ya kuthamini shughuli za kilimo na ufugaji nchini haimaanishi wafugaji wanaruhusiwa kuingiza mifugo na kulisha katika mashamba ya

wakulima, wala wakulima kudhuru mifugo ya wafugaji.

Alisitisita wafanye shughuli zao kwa kuzingatia sheria na taratibu, kwani tayari serikali imeshaandaa mpango wa matumizi bora ya ardhi kwa kutenga maeneo ya makazi, huduma za kijamii, kilimo na mifugo hiyo hakuna mwenye haki ya kumvamia mwiningine.

Majaliwa alieleza watendaji wa vijiji wahakikishe kabla ya kuwakaribisha wafugaji katika maeneo yao wajiridhishe kama wana maeneo ya kutosha kwa shughuli hiyo na kuwashirikisha wanakijiji husika juu ya ujio wa wafugaji na wafahamu idadi ya mifugo walijonayo.

"Wananchi tulieni mkiona maeneo yenu yamevamiwa toeni taarifa. Hapa tusikie tena athari hizi," alisema.

Alitumia fursa hiyo kuwataka wananchi hao waendelee na shughuli za kilimo na

kwa wanafunzi wa Tanzania.

Katika kuimarisha uhusiano huo, mwaka 2018 Tanzania na Romania zilitia saini hati ya makubaliano kuhusu ushauriano wa kisiasa na kidiplomasia.

wasiogopewa, kwani serikali ipo makini na inaendelea kuimarisha ulinzi katika maeneo yote.

Hata hiyo, wananchi hao walimweleza Waziri Mkuu Majaliwa wanaogopa kuandaa mashamba kutokana na kuhofia uvamizi wa mifugo.

Katika hatua nyininge, Majaliwa alisema Rais Dk. Samia Suluhu Hassan, alisisitiza wananchi lazima wafikishiwe huduma za kijamii karibu na makazi, hiyo kwa kushirikiana na watendaji wengine wa serikali atahakikisha miradi ya maendeleo inasimiwa na kutekelezwa ipasavyo ikiwemo kukamilika kwa wakati na viwango kusudiwa.

Pia, Majaliwa alimwagiza Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa Halmashauri ya Wilaya ya Ruangwa, Frank Chonya, kukamilisha ujenzi wa zahanati ya Kijiji cha Namilema, baada ya wananchi kumwombaa awasadie kuimalizia kutokana na kujenga boma kwa nguvu zao.

* Ulega: Rais Samia ametangaza fursa lukuki mifugo, uvuvi

WAZIRI wa Mifugo na Uvuvi, Abdallah Ulega amesema Rais Samia Suluhu Hassan amefanya kazi kubwa kutangaza fursa na kutafuta masoko katika sekta za mifugo na uvuvi.

Ulega amesema kazi alizofanya Rais Samia nchini Saudi Arabia imewezesha nchi kupata soko la nyama kuanza uzalishaji wa majani ya kulisha mifugo.

Ulega alisema hayo Ikulu Dar es Salaam jana kwenye mkutano wa waandishi wa habari ulioandalowi na Kuru genzi ya Mawasiliano ya Rais Ikulu kuzungumzia ziara ya Rais Samia nchini Morocco na Saudi Arabia Novemba 8 hadi 11, mwaka huu.

Alisema mwaka 2021 Tanzania iliuza tani 1,700

za nyama nje ya nchi lakini mpaka sasa imeuza zaidi ya tani 14,000.

"Haya mambo hayaji kimasihara ni kutokana na jitihada na mikakati na ni kutokana na matokeo ya ziara ambazo Rais Samia amezifanya ili kuongeza zaidi biashara na kuvutia wawekezaji," alisema Ulega.

Alisema Saudi Arabia pekee ambaao awali hawakuwa wakichukua nyama kutoka Tanzania mpaka Juni mwaka huu wamenunua tani 1,400 na mahitaji yao ni tani 20,000 kwa mwezi.

"Mifugo ni utajiri hivyo ni lazima tutangulize kwanza biashara yaani kila anayefuga afuge kwa malengo ya kupata fedha. Kila baada ya muda tunavuna na kipeleka sokoni ili kuweza kufaidika. Kwani hata tani hizi 14,000 tulizoziua asilimia 80 ni mbuzi na kon-

doo kwa upande wa ng'ombe bado hatujafanikiwa," alisema Ulega.

Alisema serikali imekua ikifanya mbinu kuongeza uzalishaji wa ng'ombe wanaokidhi vigezo vya soko la nje ya nchi.

Alivitaka vyama vya ushirika vya wafugaji kuhamasisha wafugaji wavune mifugo yao na kutajirika na isiwe fahari kuwa na ng'ombe 1,000 mpaka 2,000 huku mifugo hiyo ikiwa haiendi sokoni.

Ulega alitaja mikakati ya kuongeza uzalishaji wa nyama kuwa ni kupitia upandikizaji wa mbegu bora na kupitia Kampuni ya Ranchi za Taifa (NARCO) kwa kuifanya kuwa kampuni mama ya biashara ya nyama na pia kupitia programu ya Jenga Kesho Iliyo Bora (BBT).

"Kwenye BBT tutatumia vijana ambaao ni wafanyabi-

ashara wa mifugo kila mmoja kupitia vikundi vyao ana akaunti benki kwa ajili ya kuwezesha. Tunataka hawa wanaotaka nyama wananelenepeshewa moja kwa moja kupitia hawa vijana ambaao tunawapa vitalu wazalishhe na kuuza kulingana na mahitaji," alisema.

Aliongeza: "Tuna mifugo mingi sana ila changamoto inakua mtu anapohitaji inakua shida kuipata na ni kwa sababu wafugaji wako scattered hivyo tunachokifanya ni kustreamline ili wenye kuhitaji kununua wasipate tabu."

Pia, kupitia mkutano huo, Ulega alitangaza mpango wa serikali kuanzisha kampeni ya kila mfugaji nchini lazima mifugo yake ichanjwe ili kuondoa magonjwa ya mifugo yanayoweza kuleta changamoto kwenye soko la mifugo.

Dar plans livestock mass vaccination

TANZANIA intends to undertake a nationwide livestock mass vaccination campaign to increase the livestock export market and farmers' revenues.

Livestock and Fisheries Minister Abdallah Ulega disclosed this yesterday at the State House in Dar es Salaam during a news conference on President Samia Suluhu Hassan's trips to Morocco and Saudi Arabia, held between November 8 and 11 this year.

Mr Ulega stated that one of the challenges facing Tanzanian livestock in meeting export requirements was pests and diseases, and the campaign was one of the measures employed by the government to shift the narrative.

"At present, they vaccinate, but everyone does it according to their schedule. We want every livestock keeper to vaccinate, and we will de-

velop a specific vaccination schedule for each livestock disease," he stated.

He asserted that the campaign would contribute to increasing confidence in Tanzania's meat standards and quality among the nations with whom Tanzania conducts interna-

tion business.

At present, they vaccinate, but everyone does it according to their schedule. We want every livestock keeper to vaccinate, and we will develop a specific vaccination schedule for each livestock disease."

In order to continue fostering confidence among overseas purchasers, the government has also set aside disease-free compartment zones.

Mr Ulega said that during their visit to Saudi Arabia, they had meetings with the Almarai company, which is ready to come to Tanzania and start a project to produce livestock fodder. The company has already started negotiations with the Ministry of Livestock to initiate the project.

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Other companies that showed interest include the Salic Company and the Crown Agricultural Company, both of which aim to start projects for the cultivation of livestock feed (alfalfa) and a project to fatten cows for sale in the Middle East market.

"Those companies have also requested to start cooperative associations of farmers who will cultivate alfalfa livestock feed, and they will establish joint collection centres for the companies," said Mr Ulega.

He stated that Tanzania has the largest livestock population, but the problem is that when someone wants to buy, it is difficult to find since the herders are dispersed.

"So, what we are doing is streamlining the process so that those who need to buy do not have trouble," he said.

According to the minister, the deal they have with these firms is to perform contract farming. The farmers will be given seeds, and after harvesting, there will be collection centres.

"In 2021, we sold 1,700 tonnes of meat abroad, but until now, we have sold more than 14,000 tonnes. This is due to the results of the visits that President Samia has made to increase business

and attract investors," he told reporters.

According to the minister, Saudi Arabia, which did not buy meat from Tanzania until June of this year, has already purchased 1,400 tonnes, and their need is 20,000 tonnes in one month, so the opportunity is still quite large.

"The Saudis are ready to cooperate with Tanzania, and the first step is to ensure that we have our growers to be able to reach the Saudi market effectively," stated Mr Ulega.

As a government, he said they have been implementing various methods to increase the production of cows that meet the criteria of the foreign market, including artificial insemination.

In September of this year, when speaking at the Africa Food System Forum 2023 in Dar es Salaam, Minister Ulega outlined some of the interventions and opportunities focused on boosting commercial livestock production to increase the supply of raw materials for processing industries.

These interventions include the implementation of the Livestock Sector Transformation Plan (LSTP), which includes improving animal breeds through artificial insemination and the use of improved breeding bulls,

strengthening pasture and water development by establishing commercial farms for pasture and pasture seed production.

He mentioned other initiatives such as strengthening animal health systems through vaccination campaigns and control of ticks and tick-borne diseases, enhancing extension services by equipping extension officers with extension kits and transportation, research, and training.

The list of initiatives also includes the value addition of livestock products, creating an enabling environment for business and investment, and mainstreaming employment opportunities through the engagement of youth and women under the auspices of Building a Better Tomorrow through Livestock and Fisheries Entrepreneurs (BBT-LIFE).

"We have recruited 240 youth in the BBT-LIFE programme, whereby the beneficiaries have been acquainted with the necessary innovative mind transformation, entrepreneurship skills, and business-oriented perspectives. They are expected to significantly contribute to increased production, value addition, and employment inclusion," he stated.
